

# SHATTUCK AVENUE SOUTH IMPROVEMENTS TO BEGIN



**Construction is scheduled to begin on Shattuck Avenue South between S 4th Pl. and S 7th St. The construction project duration is anticipated to be approximately four months and will include the following improvements when completed:**

- The addition of a second lane under the Shattuck Avenue bridge.
- A new sidewalk under the east span of the bridge.
- Installation of a stormwater pipe to reduce flooding on Rainier Avenue.
- Installation of a “sacrificial beam” to protect the bridge from damage from over-height vehicles.

**Residents and businesses in the vicinity of the construction zone should be aware of the following:**

**Parking:** No on-street parking will be allowed within the project limits on Shattuck Ave. S during construction.

**Local Access:** Only limited local access will be allowed within the project limits on Shattuck Ave. S during construction hours.

- Driveways will be blocked for short periods while improvements are installed in front of them .  
Affected property owners will be notified in advance so they can plan accordingly.
- Properties with access to Rainier Avenue will not have access on Shattuck Avenue.
- Small sections of Shattuck Ave. S may be closed during construction hours.
- Shattuck Ave. S from Houser Way to S 4th Place will remain closed until the project is complete.

**Water Service Interruption:** 12 water service meters are scheduled to be relocated during the project. When that work occurs water will be shut off temporarily. Affected property owners will be notified in advance of the shut-off so they can plan accordingly.
