**SUBJECT: DUVALL AVENUE NE/COAL CREEK PARKWAY WIDENING/
RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT – NOTICE WORK WITHIN TEMPORARY
CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT**

Dear Resident or Occupant:

As part of the City's project, all overhead power and communication lines will be converted to underground facilities. For the properties along Duvall Avenue NE, City administration has agreed to convert these properties to underground facilities to be able to tie into the new power and communication utilities in Duvall Avenue NE as part of the City's project budget.

Progress has been made with installation of conduits and vaults within Duvall Avenue NE that are necessary for the conversion. Additional work will be needed on each individual property, and this work will be happening shortly. For the most part, this work includes trenching and placing conduit from the City right-of-way to your current service location on the outside of your home.

The City's contractor has indicated this work may start as early as today. The contractor will start in the following order:

4. 2120 Duvall Avenue
5. 2012 Duvall Avenue
6. 4621 NE 21st Place
7. 2005 Duvall Avenue

9. 1902 Duvall Avenue
10. 1800 Duvall Avenue
11. 1827 Duvall Avenue
12. 1821 Duvall Avenue

The contractor believes they may get to one or two properties a day. There will be no service interruption for this portion of work
