TRAFFIC SAFETY CAMERA SYSTEM

According to the Insurance Institute for Highway Safety, annually, nearly 2 million crashes occur in intersections. In 2005 driver's running red lights resulted in 800 fatalities and over 165,000 injuries.

Red light running is a problem. It is believed that an automated red light camera program will reduce the number of red light collisions and injuries associated with such crashes. The purpose of this program is to increase traffic safety in the City of Renton. The goal of the program is to reduce red light running violations, red light crashes, and red light injury crashes without impacting city funds.

A red light running violation occurs when a motorist enters an intersection after the traffic signal has turned red. Motorists already in the intersection when the signal changes to red, when waiting to turn for example, are not considered red light violators. The red light cameras capture two images of the alleged violation. The first image shows the vehicle at the stop bar on a steady red signal, and the second image shows the vehicle's progression through the intersection on the same red signal. These cameras will also be capturing violators who are required to stop prior to a right hand turn. Many pedestrians are injured or killed by drivers who do not come to a complete stop prior to making a right hand turn.

Cameras are estimated to be installed sometime in April with a 30 day warning period. Each intersection will be clearly marked with signs warning drivers of the new enforcement program:

- Westbound SW Grady Way and Rainier Ave S
- Southbound Sunset Blvd and Bronson Way
- Southbound East Valley Way and SW 43rd St
- Westbound 3rd Street and Sunset Blvd N

Soon after, fixed speed camera systems will be installed at the following school zones:

- Edmonds Ave NE @ McKnight Middle School
 - S. 2nd Street @ Renton High School
- Talbot Road @ Talbot Hill Elementary School

Additional information will be available as the installation date draws closer.
