FIREWORKS BAN IN EFFECT IN THE CITY OF RENTON



In an effort to protect citizens and their property, fireworks are banned in the City of Renton.

It is illegal to possess or discharge fireworks of any kind within the Renton City limits throughout the year, including the 4th of July.

The fireworks ban was officially implemented in 2005 and included the use, sale and possession of any fireworks within the city limits of Renton. Prior to the ban, property loss caused by fireworks incidents totaled \$575,000 over a five-year period, and resulted in an average of 230 calls every year related to fireworks injuries. In 2006 there were more than 1,000 fireworks-related emergency incidents statewide resulting in more than \$9 million in property loss.

The Fire & Emergency Services Department along with the Renton Police Department will actively enforce the ban and will work jointly to issue citations and confiscate fireworks. Violators are subject to both criminal and civil citations and can be fined \$100-\$500. Additionally, the sale, possession and use of explosive devices such as M-80's, M-100's, and homemade or modified fireworks are a felony offense, and violators will face criminal prosecution.
