Hello Block Watch Members!

There were **25** residential burglaries during the month of September, with **0** occurring at an active Block Watch residence. 64% of this month's burglaries were non-forced and occurred during the day. Burglaries decreased by 54% from last month.



### **PROJECT LIFESAVER** **King County Search & Rescue**



Being a personal caregiver for someone else is a difficult task. The responsibility is enormous, and can be draining. The situation can be dramatically intensified when the person that is being cared for begins to wander away. The tendency to wander is prevalent among those suffering from Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia. Reasoning, judgment, the ability to communicate, and other behaviors can all be affected.

The wanderer's inability or unwillingness to communicate has frustrated caregivers and searchers alike. Traditional search methods rely heavily on the ability of the lost person to respond to searchers when they call. When this ability does not exist or the person elects not to respond, search efforts can be time consuming, and can sometimes take a tragic turn.

Project Lifesaver is designed to provide a safety net for the most vulnerable citizens in our community. Each Project Lifesaver client is provided a one ounce electronic bracelet that emits a unique radio signal 24-hours a day. When a client wanders, a call to 9-1-1 by the caregiver triggers a rapid response by a trained team with King County Volunteer Search and Rescue. Under the direction of the Sheriff's Office, a search is started to locate that client's unique radio signal as soon as possible.



The Alzheimer's Association of Western Washington endorses and supports Project Lifesaver. They recognize that this new technology will provide an important safety net for those affected by Alzheimer's disease or related dementias in the community.
