

Proclamation

Whereas, the City of Renton recognizes and supports local health care institutions and the services that they provide to the community; and

Whereas, HealthPoint, a nonprofit, community-based network of health centers, is celebrating the 50th anniversary of its investment in the health of people and communities in Renton and King County; and

Whereas, HealthPoint provides high quality, integrated primary health care to all, regardless of ability to pay, and has 980 HealthPoint employees serving more than 100,000 patients and providing more than 350,000 visits a year because Everyone Deserves Great Care; and

Whereas, the HealthPoint administration office has been in Renton since 2006, and HealthPoint has 20 locations in King County including three in Renton: Renton Health Center, Sunset Neighborhood Center, and Renton High School; and

Whereas, HealthPoint has worked with the City of Renton to improve the overall health of our community by providing medical, dental, and behavioral health services and pharmacy services in under-served areas, including the Sunset Neighborhood Center and the future Family First Community Center; and

Whereas, HealthPoint's response to the COVID pandemic was extraordinary, including the transformation of an emissions check facility in Renton into a testing and vaccination site and developing a telemedicine practice to keep patients safe;

Now, therefore, I, Armondo Pavone, Mayor of the City of Renton, do hereby proclaim August 9, 2021 to be

in the City of Renton, and I encourage all citizens to join me in this special observance.
