Carbon Dioxide Reduction

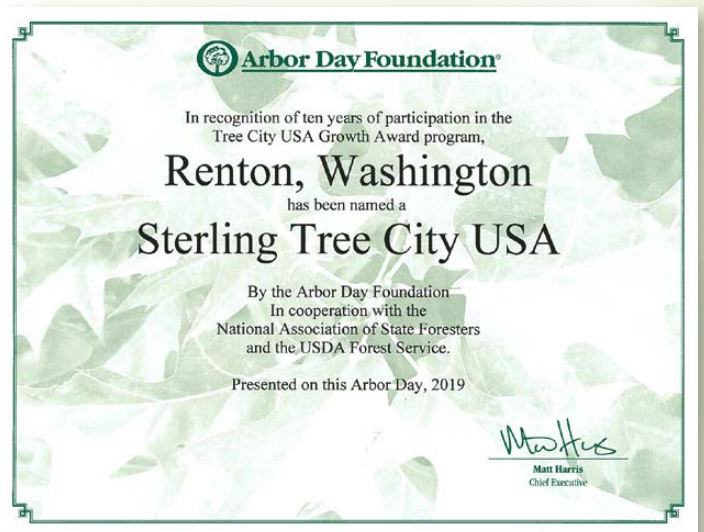
Amount of carbon dioxide our city trees sequestered—turning greenhouse gas into wood.
