POLICE

You will have the opportunity to contribute to the overall quality of service the Police Department provides to the community. Opportunities include Chaplain, Records Clerk, Fingerprint Technician, Training Unit Assistant, Special Events Assistant, Front Counter Support, and Auto Theft Mapping.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

There are many ways you can help during an emergency! Become a CERT (Community Emergency Response Team) volunteer or a RECS (Renton Emergency Communication Service) volunteer. CERT training program helps communities prepare for and respond to disasters. A RECS (Renton Emergency Communication Service) volunteer is a licensed amateur radio volunteer who provides backup communications for the city in an emergency.

RENTON HISTORY MUSEUM

We are always looking for committed volunteers who are enthusiastic about Renton's history to help with Saturday greeting, leading tours, assisting with programs, and working on our oral history team.



SURFACE WATER

RENTON FARMERS MARKET

SEASONAL Help support local family farms and small businesses by volunteering at the Renton Farmers Market! Volunteers assist with daily market operations including setting up and taking down the market, operations of the information booth, assisting with attendance counts, public surveys, vendor checks and more.

TRAIL RANGER PROGRAM

SEASONAL Cedar River Trail Rangers utilize a golf cart and monitor the trail for safety issues while documenting trail use observations. They help educate users on trail etiquette, additional regulations and provide assistance to trail users.

SEASONAL Park Ambassadors engage with park patrons and assist with directions and information about park rules, programs and events. They promote stewardship and participation in the community and help provide safe and enjoyable outdoor experiences for all!
