## Racquetball League Rules

1. League Matches are best of 3 games: 2 games to 15 points. If necessary, the $3^{\text {rd }}$ game is a tiebreaker to 11 points. If a match has not been completed by the end of the scheduled hour, the player ahead at that time wins the game.
2. Record your own points on the bulletin board (located outside court \#1 at RCC) in the appropriate League/Division section. Scoring will be as follows:

4 points if you win the match in 2 games
3 points if you win the match in 3 games
2 points if you lose the match in 3 games
1 point if you lose the match in 2 games
0 points if you do not play the match
Please use the scoring system above. Always record your points
ACROSS from YOUR name in the column of your opponent's number.
3. If you need to reschedule a match, you must get the consent of your opponent. After deciding on a date/time for the make-up match, you must notify the League Coordinator (Brandi Burke or Andy O'Brien) in order for a court to be reserved and the hourly fee to be waived.
4. All make-ups must be completed by the last official day of league play (last regular season match) in order to be counted towards playoff seeding.
