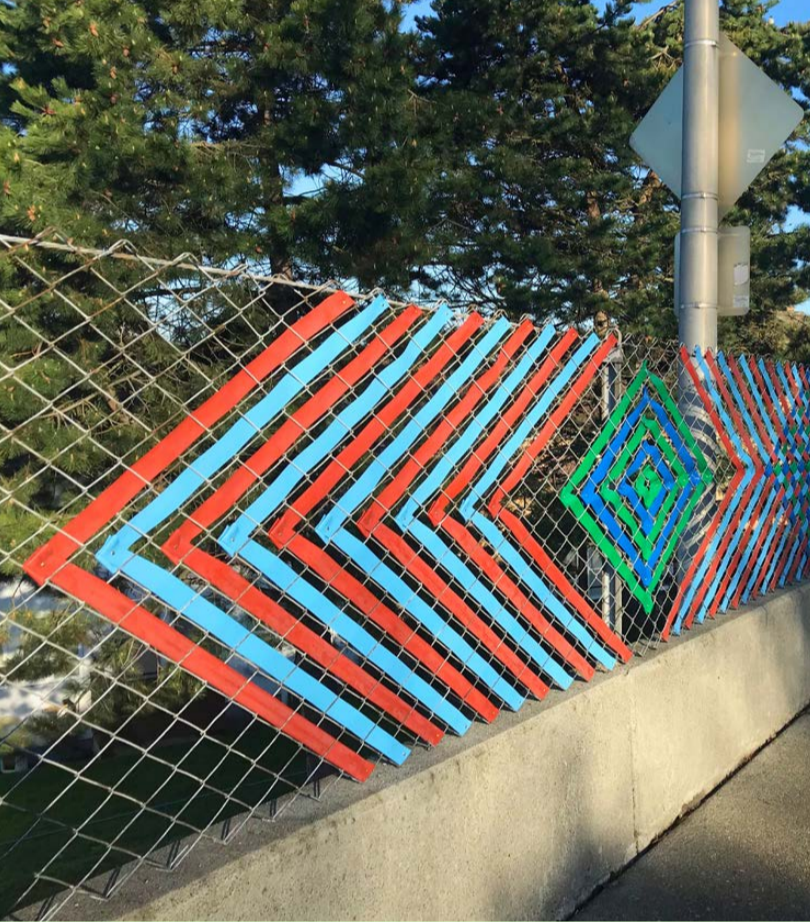


NOW AVAILABLE! The 2019 Senior Revue
