GEORGE AND ANNIE LEWIS CUSTER AWARD Historical Society honors Kirkman mural

The Renton Historical Society has awarded the team who organized and created the Boone Kirkman mural the 2019 George and Annie Lewis Custer Award for Heritage Stewardship. The team included Fay Moss, originator of the idea, Will Schlough, mural artist, and city Community and Economic Development staffers John Collum and Jessie Kotarski. The Custer Award is given annually to a group or individual who has made an extraordinary accomplishment in the documentation, preservation, interpretation or education of Renton's unique heritage. The Kirkman mural is located at 811 S. Third St.
