Minimum requirements

- » Applicant must be at least 18 years of age
- » Possess good moral character
- » Pass a background check
- » Ability to maintain a positive attitude
- » Good people skills
- » Abide by a strict procedural protocol
- » Valid driver's license
- » No criminal record and/or association with criminal activity
- » No history of alcohol or drug addiction and abuse in the last 10 years
- » Ability to commit to a minimum of four hours a week
- » Ability to successfully complete the application and screening process

Selection process

- » **Oral Interview:** Selected applicants will be invited to an oral interview panel to evaluate their qualifications.
- » **Background Investigation:** Applicants will undergo a thorough background investigation.

Upon acceptance the Police Volunteer Coordinator will schedule an orientation and training session.
