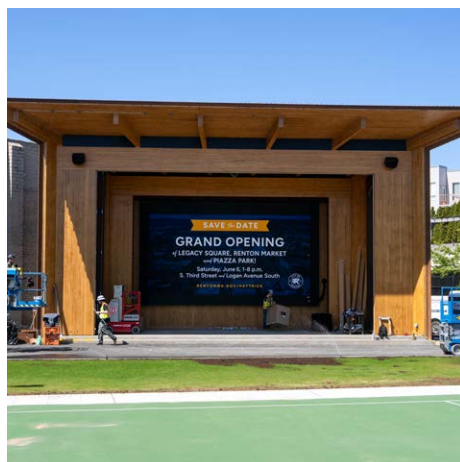
Our biggest summer yet!

PICKPOCKETING PREVENTION

At large events, stay alert and secure your belongings. Use zippered bags worn in front, keep pockets empty, and leave extra valuables at home. Watch for distractions in crowded spaces and always trust your instincts to stay safe.

Over 61? You may be eligible for Renton's Utility Tax Rebate Program

THE UTILITY TAX REBATE PROGRAM

offers partial reimbursement of city utility taxes for low-income seniors (61+) and low-income residents with permanent disabilities. If you've already qualified for reduced utility rates, your rebate will automatically be processed. All other eligible participants can apply now through June 15. To see if you're eligible, visit: rentonwa.gov/UtilityRebate

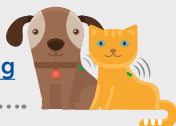
