- ✗ NO television sets or computers
- ✗ NO car chassis
- ✗ NO refrigerators, dishwashers or microwaves

(Bagged packing peanuts accepted)

Clean white block Styrofoam (Look for #6 or EPS inside the recycle symbol)

- ✗ NO tape or labels

Plastic Bags

Grocery bags, film, clean food bags, plastic amazon envelopes

- ✗ NO hard plastics, tarps, toys or totes

Mattress, Cardboard, Styrofoam, Plastic Bags & Tire Collection

Mattresses & Box Springs

Must be dry and no excessive stains, no bed bugs and no blood stains
(\$35 cash for each piece)

Clean white block Styrofoam (#6 or EPS in symbol)

- ✗ NO tape or labels

Plastic Bags

Grocery bags, film, clean food bags, plastic amazon envelopes

- ✗ NO hard plastics, tarps, toys or totes

Tires: Car, Pickup Truck & Motorcycle

Bias ply, steel belted and studded tires accepted (Take tires off rims; limit 10 tires)



- ✗ NO semi truck or tractor tires

Documents for Shredding

Bring up to 4 Boxes (banker box size 12"x15"x10") or equivalent in bags
(Paper, blueprints, mail, photographs, and file folders accepted; No need to remove staples, paper clips or rubber bands)

- ✗ NO binders, plastics or discs
- ✗ NO ID badges or driver's licenses
- ✗ NO cardboard or hard cover books
