Exhibit B: Larvicide Treatment Sites

The City of Renton may use mosquito larvicides made of a natural bacterium (*Bacillus sphaericus*) to help control mosquitoes in accordance with the Washington State Department of Ecology's Aquatic Mosquito Control General Permit. Treatments may occur between June and September. Larvicide treatment will generally occur in stormwater facilities owned or maintained by the City.
